



GOOD ENVIRONMENTAL PRACTICES ON THE BEACHES OF LLUCMAJOR

The municipality of Lluçmajor has implemented an environmental management system certified according to the international standard **ISO 14001:2015** on its beaches and bathing areas.

The town council is aware of both the natural wealth of these areas and their intensive use. For these reasons, the objective of the Environmental Management System is to improve the environmental behavior of all the people involved and to prevent the deterioration of the coastal area.

The aim is to strengthen environmental protection and pollution prevention in balance with the socio-economic needs of the municipality.

This management involves **working to reduce the impact** on the environment, ensuring the control of **sustainable behavior** of services and activities carried out on the beaches, as well as informing users of good practices.

Annual audits are carried out to certify compliance and monitoring of this management system.

We also recommend that you check the capacity of each beach before you go, especially in the summer months. This way you will be able to better enjoy your day at the beach.

Good Practices and Recommendations

1. Respect the flora and fauna on the sand and in the sea. Everything has its function in nature.

Do not pull up plants from the beach. If you arrive by boat, use the strategically placed anchoring buoys. Do not drop anchor over *areas/meadows where there is Neptune grass (Mediterranean tape weed, Posidonia Oceanica)*.

2. Access the beach only through the authorised passages.

3. Leave your vehicle in the designated car parks.

4. Do not litter the beach. Leave your rubbish in the litter bins provided on the beach. *If it is a beach without a cleaning service/bins*, take your rubbish with you until you find a suitable container to dispose of it in.

Plastic takes between 100 and 1,000 years to decompose.

The rubbish you leave on a beach such as cigarette butts, cans, snack bags and many others, take decades to decompose. *To avoid this*, take a large bag *with you* to the beach to collect all your waste and then dispose of it in the appropriate container.

80% of MARINE WASTE *reaches the sea by land*, i.e. it comes from the abandonment of waste *not only on the shore but also in the street*. Every year about 10 MILLION TONS OF GARBAGE reach the sea!!!

We encourage you to use **reusable containers** to take your drinks to the beach.



5. If you smoke, don't throw cigarette butts on the sand: Cigarette butts contain thousands of components that can pollute the environment with toxic and soluble chemicals. They threaten water quality and many forms of aquatic life.

6. Water is a scarce commodity. Make reasonable use of showers: DO NOT WASTE WATER, or use it to clean utensils or the like. DO NOT USE SOAP IN SHOWERS, as the sewage system goes directly into the sea.

7. Do not disturb with noise the calm of the *environment* and the tranquillity of other users.

8. Do not carry sand on your accessories or on your body. Nature needs thousands of years to create it, so it has to stay in its natural habitat. Wipe off the sand before you leave the beach to help it stay there. *It is estimated that every bather removes more than 15 kg of sand from the beach every year. Every grain counts*

9. Respect the rules and prohibition signs regarding dog access to beaches.

10. Before leaving the beach, check the place you have occupied to make sure it is completely clean.

Spread these good environmental practices. The beach belongs to everyone, collaborate with its conservation.
